Public Consultation - Proposed Changes to Parking Restrictions - Installation of Two Disabled Parking Spaces
- Burdett Street, Hornsby

Council is writing to you about a proposal to install two parking spaces for people with disabilities in Burdett Street, Hornsby. Council wants to get the balance right and would like your feedback.

The Proposal

Council is considering providing two parking spaces for people with disabilities in Burdett Street, near the intersection with Palmerston Road, to improve visitor access to the nearby church and local medical services in the area. The proposed restrictions will be installed along the northern side of the roadway utilising the existing 90-degree parking spaces.

A plan attached to this letter shows the location of the parking spaces and the proposed signs.

Next Steps

Council invites your comments on the proposal by **close of business Monday 12 February 2024**. The results of the consultation will be referred to the Hornsby Local Traffic Committee for consideration and recommendation to Council.
