## **Public Consultation - Mambara Track Accessibility Improvements**

## The Proposal

Council is proposing an accessibility upgrade to the Mambara Track though inclusion of accessible parking alongside Britannia Street, Pennant Hills.

Key features of the proposal are:

- 1. Installation of two accessible parking bays, parallel with Britannia Street.
- 2. Upgrade existing walking track with concrete path linking to the Mambara Track.
- 3. Installation of parking signs.

Council invites your comments on the proposal by close of business Friday 8th March 2024. The results of the consultation will be referred to the Hornsby Local Traffic Committee for consideration and recommendation to Council.
